The town of Ceredo was founded in 1857 by Eli Thayer, determined to prove that a town could be prosperous without the use of slave labor. He personally invited Zopher D. Ramsdell, to join. In 1858, Ramsdell completed his home at 1108 B Street, Ceredo. Legend has it the home was built on Indian burial grounds and was the last stop on the Underground Railroad.
